Dear Karla -

In the early 2000s, we watched as whistleblowers Sherron Watkins and Cynthia Cooper witnessed and reported massive fraud and corruption. Their reports ultimately brought down the huge corporations that were Enron and WorldCom

Those were hardly the only companies plagued with these issues. In the nearly two decades since, we've all seen so many organizations that people believed were too big to fail fall apart due to this type of abuse and fraud. The kind that crashed our economy in 2008. The kind that destroyed so many jobs and family savings.

That's why it is so important that we protect the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) whistleblower program. **They're scheduled to vote on proposed changes that would gut the program this Wednesday.**

Whistleblowers are one of the most important ways to combat corporate fraud. But now the SEC wants to make it incredibly challenging for whistleblowers to report fraud and is destroying incentives to do so.

It's critical that this doesn't happen, **but we only have two days left to prevent it.**
